



The 6th edition of the **International Conference on Connected Smart Cities (CSC 2020)** (part of the IADIS Multi Conference on Computer Science and Information Systems 2020) was held virtually due to the COVID-19 pandemic, during **21-23 July 2020**.

This conference was organized by the International Association for Development of the Information Society (IADIS).

The CSC conference aims at discussing the social, behavioral, technical, economic, and environmental impacts of the introduction of smart city applications and services. The 2020 edition was jointly published with the 13th International Conference on ICT, Society and Human Beings (ICT 2020) and 17th International Conference Web Based Communities and Social Media (WBC 2020). These conferences received 136 submissions from more than 22 countries. Each submission was anonymously reviewed by an average of four independent reviewers, to ensure that accepted submissions were of a high standard. Consequently, only 23 full papers were approved which means an acceptance rate of 17%. A few more papers were accepted as short papers, reflection papers and poster.

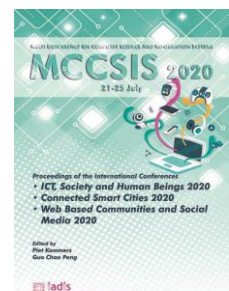
