



The 8th edition of the **International Conference on Connected Smart Cities** (CSC 2022) (part of the IADIS 16th Multi Conference on Computer Science and Information Systems 2022) was held in Lisbon, Portugal, during **19-21 July 2021**.

This conference was organized by the International Association for Development of the Information Society (IADIS).

The CSC conference aims at discussing the social, behavioral, technical, economic, and environmental impacts of the introduction of smart city applications and services. The 2022 edition was jointly published with the 16th International Conference on Computer Graphics, Visualization, Computer Vision and Image Processing (CGVCVIP 2022), 6th International Conference on Big Data Analytics, Data Mining and Computational Intelligence (BigDaCI'22) and 11th International Conference on Theory and Practice in Modern Computing (TPMC 2022). These conferences received 161 submissions from more than 23 countries. Each submission was anonymously reviewed by an average of five independent reviewers, to ensure that accepted submissions were of a high standard. Consequently, only 24 full papers were published. The overall acceptance rate corresponds to about 15%. A few more papers were accepted as short papers, reflection papers and posters.

Besides the papers' and posters' presentations, the conferences also included one keynote presentation by Professor Xiaoru Yuan, School of AI, Peking University, China.

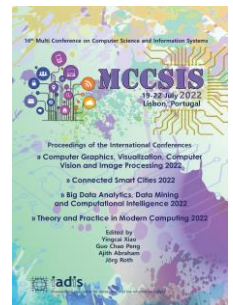
